My Fellow Umpires (to include Umpire Groupies, Umpire Cheer Squad, Umpire Booster Club Members, and others):

Everyone (including players, admins, staff, coaches, umpires, family in attendance, etc.) attending USAFL Nationals 2021 must submit either:

- (1) Proof of Covid-19 vaccination, or
- (2) Proof of a negative Covid-19 test result (PCR or rapid test)
 - a. Administered by a health professional (home tests will not be accepted)
 - b. Taken Wednesday, October 13, 2021 at 8am or later, and
 - c. Submitted to the USAFL no later than Friday, October 15, 2021, 5pm or earlier.


If you're not vaccinated and won't be by Nationals 2021 (A person is considered fully vaccinated 14 days after the second shot of Pfizer/Moderna or single shot of Johnson&Johnson. The last possible date to get your second shot for entry on Saturday, October 16 would be October 2.) will likely need to preschedule a covid test that can be taken and have results returned within the limited timeframe noted above.

People with no vaccination or appropriate negative test results submitted to the league in a timely fashion may not attend the tournament. There will not be any exceptions allowed. Walk-ins, people showing up on Saturday morning without completing the safety requirements in the timeline provided will not be eligible to work or play.

In order to submit your vaccination or test results, you must register with the league. This is very simple to do. Go to the USAFL website (www.usafl.com) and click on the 'registration' link on the left side of the screen (red arrow below). If you're already registered, then log in, or go through the 'forgot password' link to recover your password. If you're not already registered, then go through the 'Create new account" link. All in the red oval below.




Create your new account (a couple minutes to enter data and waivers) or get logged in to your existing account (provide any missing data). Remember that umpires do not pay league dues unless they are also players. See the example umpire profile below:



Click on the USAFL logo to return to the home page (www.usafl.com). Click on the "submit Covid-19 vaccine/test report" link (red oval below).



Upload the requested information (e.g. photo of vaccination card or other appropriate data). You will be taken to a confirmation screen like the one below. Note the items in the red ovals.
